UTILITIES

2026 Utility Pricing:

To maintain the level of service that Vegreville residents expect and deserve amid rising operating costs, the Town of Vegreville has implemented a 15% increase to municipal fees and charges. Even with this adjustment, Vegreville's fees remain below the average of similar municipalities. Here are the changes you can expect on your 2026 Utility Bills (effective February billing):

New Water Rates:

\$4.42 per cubic metre
Up \$0.58 per cubic metre from 2025

New Monthly Flat Fee:

\$51.95 per month
Up \$8.95 per month from 2024

- \$5.55 of the increase is the 15% user fee increase
- \$3.40 of the increase is to fund the debenture pulled for the Forced Main Upgrades
