Dog licenses are due annually by February 28th.

- Licenses can be paid online or in person at the Administration Office.
- Dog license tags must be attached to your dog's collar.
- Notify us promptly if your dog is no longer in your care to prevent charges.
- License fees are \$51.75 for altered dogs (veterinary certificate required) and \$92.00 for unaltered dogs.

Business Licenses are valid from the date they are issued until December 31st of each year and must be renewed annually by February 28 if the business intends to continue operations in the Town of Vegreville.

After February 28 of each year a 15% penalty will be added to their license fee.
